

## CONSTITUTION

### Central Kentucky Soccer Officials Association (CKSOA)

#### ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of this organization shall be the Central Kentucky Soccer Officials Association (CKSOA).

#### ARTICLE II: PURPOSE

The purpose of the Central Kentucky Soccer Officials Association (CKSOA) is to encourage and support soccer in Central Kentucky, improve referee consistency across the three National Referee Associations (USSF, NISOA, and NFIOA), provide guidance and assistance for continuing education and upgrading of soccer officials for all levels of soccer in the Central Kentucky area, and encourage good sportsmanship and fair play.

#### ARTICLE III: MEMBERSHIP

Membership requirements shall be in accordance with the By-laws of the Association.

#### ARTICLE IV: TERMS

Section 1: Association shall mean the Central Kentucky Soccer Officials Association (CKSOA).

Section 2: The Executive Committee shall be composed of the four (4) elected officers and the immediate past-President.

Section 3: The Executive Board shall consist of the Executive Committee, the three (3) appointed officers, and one or more Advisors appointed by the President.

#### ARTICLE V: OFFICERS

All officers shall be members of the Association. An officer whose membership lapses or is terminated during his/her term of office shall be considered to have resigned from office.

##### Section 1: Elected Officers

The elected officers of the Association shall be the President, Vice-president, Secretary, and Treasurer. They shall be elected as provided in the By-laws of the Association and fulfill the duties described therein.

Section 2: Appointed Officers

The following positions shall be appointed as provided in the By-laws of the Association: Assessment Coordinator, Assigning Secretary and Clinician Coordinator. Holders of these offices shall fulfill the duties described therein.

ARTICLE VI: ADVISORS

Advisors shall be appointed as provided in the By-laws of the Association and fulfill the duties assigned by the President. Advisors may or may not be members of the Association. Advisors will not have voting rights on the Executive Board.

ARTICLE VII: BUSINESS OF THE ASSOCIATION

The business of the Association shall be conducted as provided for in the By-laws of the Association.

ARTICLE VIII: AMENDMENTS

This constitution may be amended by a 3/5 majority vote of the members present at a scheduled meeting of the membership, provided that a written notice of the proposed revision or amendment is mailed to each member at least two weeks prior to such vote.
